Conductor

Job Description

The Conductor of The Louisville Youth Choir has the primary responsibility for implementing the artistic and administrative objectives of the ensemble and is responsible to the Artistic/Executive Director and the Board of Directors of The Louisville Youth Choir, Inc.

From time to time he/she may be asked to work with one of the other ensembles; no single choir shall have more than one Conductor at a time.

Artistic Responsibilities could include but are not limited to:

- 1. Supervising all areas related to choir membership in consultation and coordination with the Artistic/Executive Director:
 - A. Recruiting and auditioning students from the metropolitan area;
 - B. Keeping accurate records of attendance and dealing with any problems;
 - C. Overseeing all written information/forms as needed or requested.
- 2. Providing leadership in establishing and maintaining appropriate artistic and educational goals for these choirs;
- 3. Planning, preparing and executing all performances of The Louisville Youth Choir in consultation and coordination with the Artistic/Executive Director:
 - A. Selecting music appropriate to the artistic and educational goals established for The Louisville Youth Choir, Inc.
 - B. Supervising and coordinating with the Accompanist of The Louisville Youth Choir, guest accompanists and outside musicians for scheduled rehearsal/concerts within the budget allotted for that purpose.
- 4. Acting as Principal Conductor of Summer Camp

Administrative Responsibilities could include but are not limited to:

- 1. Performing all artistic functions as outlined above within the budget approved by the Board of Directors;
- 2. Supervising the daily management of The Louisville Youth Choir (including distributing and collecting the music and keeping accurate attendance records);
- 3. Attending Staff Meetings when scheduled;
- 4. Attending Board of Directors meetings and Committee meetings when requested;
- 5. Working with the Artistic/Executive Director to establish and implement choir rules and regulations;
- 6. Coordinating the use of volunteers with the board of directors committee for volunteerism;
- 7. Carrying out any other responsibilities established or requested by the Artistic/Executive Director or the Board of Directors.

Qualifications

The Conductor should exhibit the following characteristics and/or qualifications:

- 1. Work effectively with young people and their families;
- 2. Work effectively with the entire Louisville Youth Choir staff and the Board of Directors;
- 3. Channel the coordination of activities through the Artistic/Executive Director;
- 4. Be knowledgeable about the public, private and home schools, religious institutions and music educators in the area;
- 5. Demonstrate good oral and written communication skills;
- 6. Be an accomplished musician with experience in conducting choral groups;
- 7. Hold a Bachelor's Degree in choral conducting or music education;
- 8. Be familiar with and/or active member of the Music Educators National Conference, American Choral Directors Association and any other appropriate professional music organizations;
- 9. Possess strong organizational skills;
- 10. Be knowledgeable of community resources;
- 11. Maintain and improve musical skills, knowledge and experience.
